After FDR's death, Eleanor turned the main house at Hyde Park over to the United States, as FDR intended, but she kept Val-Kill, purchasing the land from the Roosevelt estate and making Val-Kill Cottage her permanent home. She continued the tradition of casual entertaining, hosting world dignitaries such as Winston Churchill, Marshal Tito, Haile Selassie, and Jawaharlal Nehru.

After a short ride, we will be dining at "The Shadows", overlooking the Hudson. **We have arranged for a three-course luncheon, the cost of which is included in the \$80 Boomers fee for the day.**

Then on to the Kedem Winery for a wine tasting. You'll enjoy wines produced at the winery and an international selection of fine wines imported by Kedem's parent company, Royal Wine Corp. There are a wide variety of wines to taste from New York State, California, Australia, France, Italy, Israel, Chile, Spain, Portugal, New Zealand, and Hungary.

As an added treat, we'll be stopping at The Rockland Bakery on the way home, so you can load up on their fine breads, bagels, cakes, pies and pastries.
