Boat Ride Up The Hudson And Shakespeare

Join us for a full day of excitement as we take a ride up the Hudson and visit castles, both in this world and in the world of Shakespeare.

We start the day with a boat ride on the Hudson, stopping at one of the oddities of the East, Bannerman Castle. Located on Pollepel Island, it was built by Francis Bannerman in 1901 as an arsenal and storage location for surplus munitions. After Bannerman's death in 1918 a series of explosions and fires led to its abandonment. But, it is still making news. On April 19, 2015, the island was the destination of a kayak trip taken by Angelika Graswald and her fiancé, Vincent Viafore. Viafore did not return, and Graswald was charged with his murder. On July 24, 2017, she plead guilty to criminally negligent homicide.

We will be stopping in Cold Spring, where there will be time for lunch and shopping.

Then, on to Boscobel. With its breathtaking views of the Hudson River, Boscobel provides the perfect setting for the Hudson Valley Shakespeare Festival's 30th Anniversary summer season. HVSF has established a reputation for lucid, imaginative, engaging and highly inventive productions staged on Boscobel's historic Great Lawn with a backdrop of stunning vistas overlooking the Hudson River. We will be attending a performance of one of Shakespeare's great comedies, Love's Labour's Lost.
