Class Moms 2021-2022

Thank you for your interest in the Class Mom role for the upcoming 2021-2022 school year! This role, while always an important one, is especially important this year as we navigate new school protocols. While parents will not be permitted in the school building for the time being, it will be even more important to find ways to connect with one another and stay informed on the happenings around school.

Each class will consist of two class moms to share these responsibilities. In the event that there are more than two volunteers per class for this role, a lottery will be drawn.

Class mom responsibilities will include:

- ❖ Sending class emails to keep all parents up-to-date on upcoming events and announcements (emails with information to send/forward will be provided to you by the PA as needed throughout the year).
- ❖ Assist teachers in organizing class events and parties (Thanksgiving, Hanukkah, Passover, etc). Check in with your teachers to see how you can help organize/prepare.
- ❖ Organize a parent's night out by **October 8**. In the past class parents have organized a "mom's night out" or "parents night out" style class dinner so that everyone can get to know one another. If there are concerns regarding social gatherings, we encourage you to gather outdoors in a socially distant manner for drinks and/or dinner.
- ❖ Organize other class dates with or without the children throughout the year. The kids also enjoy seeing each other outside of school and on days off. Feel free to work with other class parents and do things as a grade if you wish in whatever way you are most comfortable.
- ❖ When available, attend school-wide events to represent your class. Often people are interested in attending events but are unsure if others are attending. We would love to see a representative from each class at all events.
- ❖ Promote upcoming events and encourage families to attend by spreading the word verbally, via e-mail, or via text.
- ❖ Take pictures of the children in your class when attending events. *TBD*
- ❖ When available, volunteer to represent your class at school day events such as Israel's birthday and field day and/or assist in securing other parent volunteers for these days so that all classes are represented.
